

## U – 23 competition of national teams at 23./24.02.2008 in Salzburg

Type of Competition:	team and single competition for national teams with players, who are not older than year of birth 1985. Player up to year of birth 1979 is allowed only, if they played no international competition the last two years.
Team Structure:	Mixed four-player teams, where is at least one player of both of the categories "male" and "female". Each team can nominate a substitute player. He can be substituted once, if the rules of team-mixing are kept.
Permission to take part:	The competition is open for teams from all invited federations. Every nation is allowed to play with two team's additional one substitute for each team.
Mode:	Team competition is played as a match for winning lanes. Single competition is played by total score after 10 rounds For more details see below.
Tournament groups:	All teams will play in one group. Each team plays two times against each other team. The teams from the same nation have to play against his other national team at the first and the second round of the tournament. (mode has to be adapted, if more teams as 2007 take part)

Composition of pairings:	For team competition according to draw and the position inside the teams.
Players per playing group:	2 players
Course ready for practice:	One week before the competition
Tournament schedule:	Saturday, 23.02.2008 from 08:30 a.m. until appr. 6 p.m., 6 rounds
	Sunday 24.02.2008: from 08:30 a.m. until appr. 2 p.m., 4 rounds
Practicing time:	The practicing time starts at 7:30 a.m. and ends at 08.15 a.m.
Victory ceremony:	Sunday 24.02.2008 around 3 p.m.
Tournament officer:	to be decided
Referees:	The referees will be chosen just before the competition OEBGV offers one not playing head referee
Jury:	The jury is constituted by the responsible tournament director of WMF.
Entries:	please send obligatory entries until 31.12.2007 to Austrian Federation, attn Willy Bauer (E-Mail: w.bauer@bauersound.at)
Participation fee:	5 Euro per player and day for using the minigolf indoor facility
Sport clothes:	permission for participation is given only to teams with uniform sport clothes according WMF sport rules and regulations.
Coaches:	For each nation are two coaches allowed.
Others:	Furthermore there are valid the WMF sport rules and regulations and all participants acknowledge with their participation the WADA-code in the actual version.

## Mode for the U 23 competition at 23. + 24. 02. 2008 in Salzburg

## Team ranking:

All teams are playing in one tournament group. A team consists of four players plus substitute.

Every team faces each other team at least one time (depending on the number of participating teams). In reason of no manipulation the first two games of day one the teams of the same nation have to face each other. For the rest of the tournament schedule there will be a drawing before the games start.

Within one game the players with the same position (positions have to be fixed before the tournament) in their teams face each other for an 18-hole-match. These four matches of position one to four start directly behind each other. For each lane, where a player achieves a better score than his opponent, he wins one point. The number of won lanes is counted after the 4 matches in a game. The team with the higher number of won lanes wins 2 points for the group table. Equal score leads to 1 point for each of the teams.

All won points count for the group table. The team with most points after all matches wins. If two teams have equal points, the team with the higher number of won lanes is ranked better. If the number of won lanes is equal too, there will be a team sudden death beginning from lane 1, played in the same mode. The team that wins more pairs at a lane wins the sudden death.

## Singles Competition:

Single competition is played by total score after 10 rounds
